Cacti



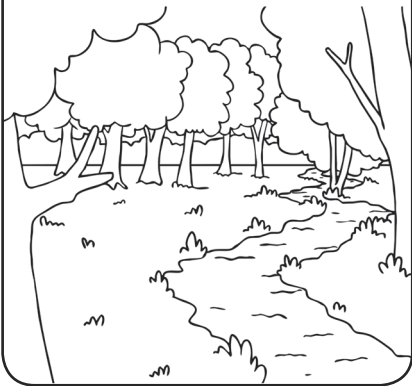
Cacti have lots of roots to collect water. Their strong stems can store water for a long time if there isn't any rain.

Sea Kale

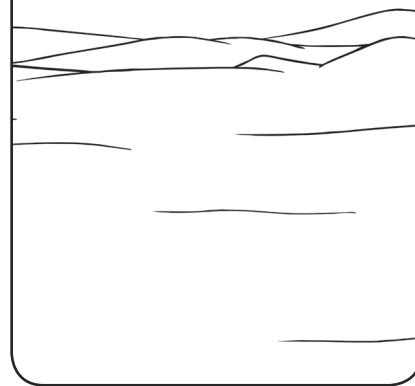


Sea kale grows well even in windy conditions. It doesn't need much soil to grow in.

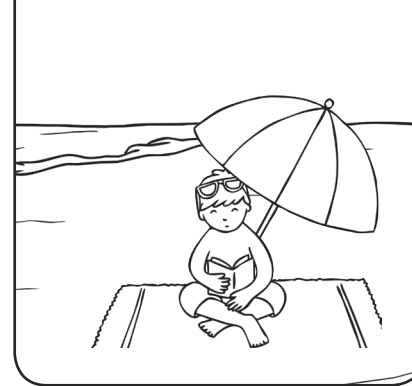
