Make patterns using 2-D shapes



You will need:

- scissors
- glue
- coloured pencils
- paper

What to do

• Ask your child to make a simple mosaic pattern using triangles, squares and rectangles. They cut out the mosaic pieces and then arrange them in a pattern on a piece of paper so that there is no overlapping or gaps between the pieces. Stick the shapes down and then colour them to make a pattern.
