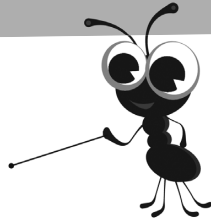

Going shopping

Use coins to pay for items



You will need:

- 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins
