

Pontesbury C.E. (Controlled) Primary School is situated in the village of Pontesbury approximately 5 miles south-west of Shrewsbury. The village of Pontesbury is large and provides many amenities which include various shops, , post office and several good places to eat!

The school, which opened in 1961, is the only primary school in the village. It draws children from Pontesbury itself and a number of children travel in from other nearby villages.

Currently there are 211 children on roll. The school is a co-education primary school for children aged 4-11 years.

Accommodation includes eight classrooms with associated practical areas, a large hall, a reference library area, a design technology area and an outdoor learning environment for the Foundation Stage. The school is set in extensive, attractive grounds, bordered by beautiful countryside.

The school has a large environmental area with a pond, an adventure play area and young woodland. Staffing currently stands at Head plus eight teachers. There are twelve teaching assistants, a school business manager, two clerical assistants, a cleaner in charge, one midday supervisor and four cleaners. School meals are cooked on site.

The staff at Pontesbury C.E. Primary School are dedicated, extremely hard working and passionate about teaching. All the staff work well together as a team and generate an incredibly caring ethos which we wish to maintain.

The parent body is very supportive of the school and works in close partnership with the school's philosophy, that all children have a right to succeed and that all children have the right to an excellent education. Parents are encouraged to take part in their children's education and are welcomed into school to help whenever possible.
