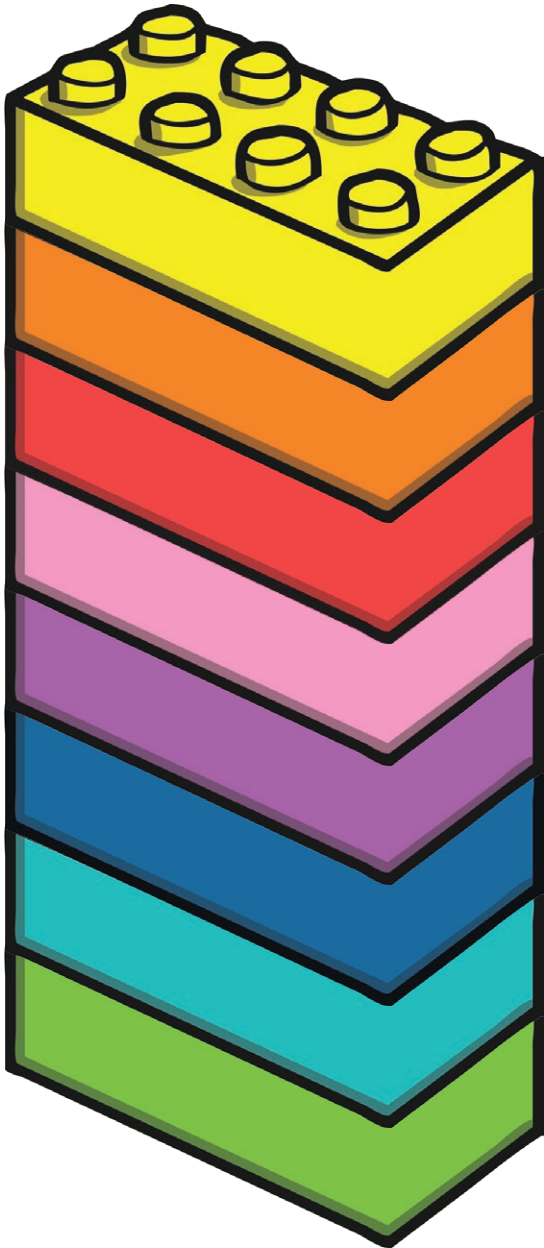


Building Brick Towers



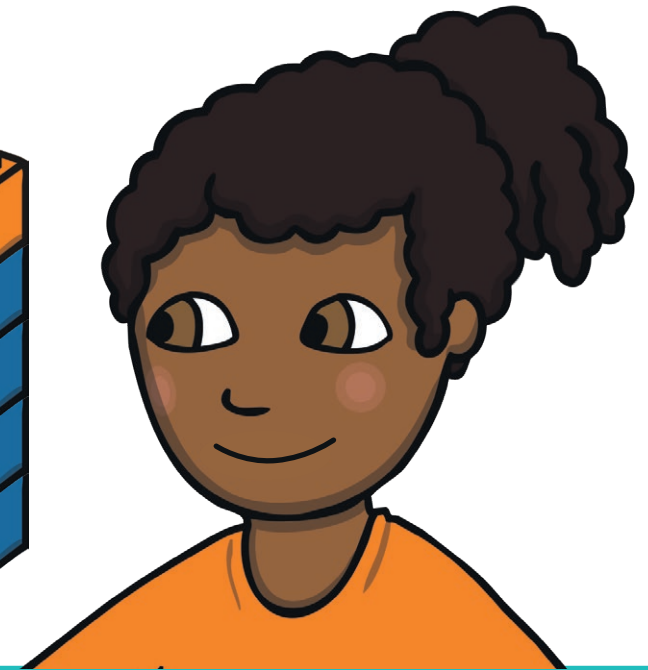
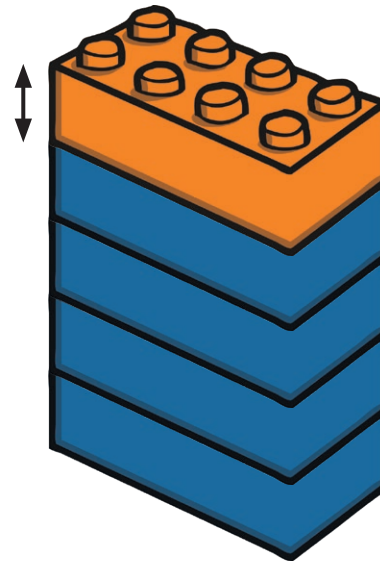
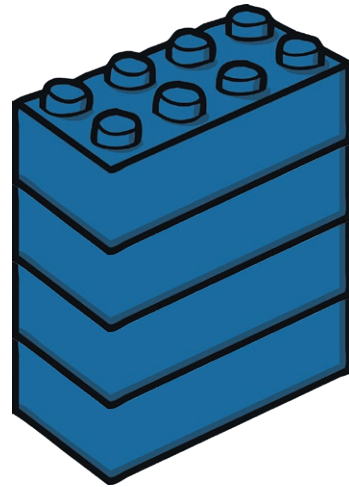
The children have some new building bricks. They are using the bricks to build towers.

Dylan and Bisma have used building bricks to build two towers.

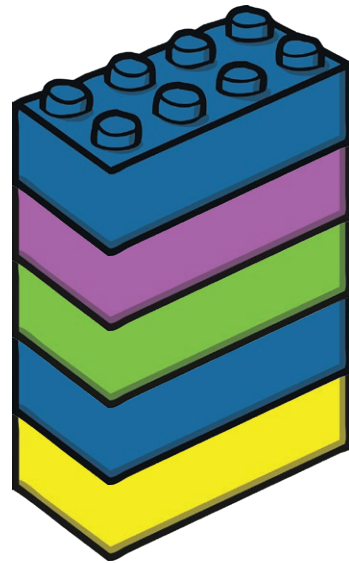
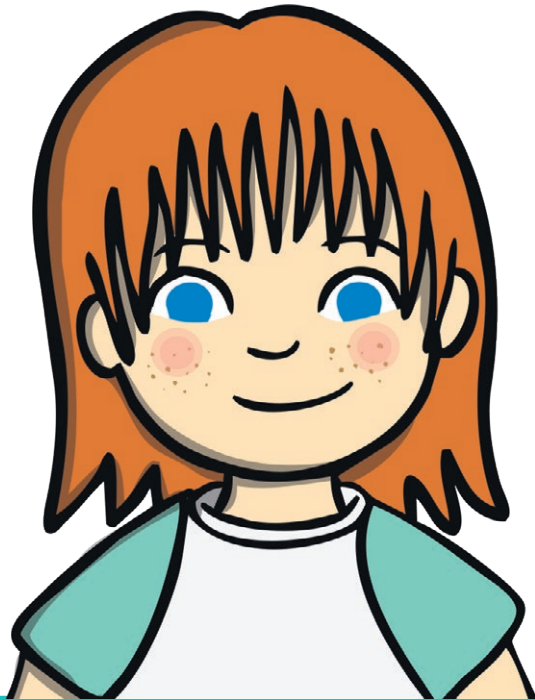
